Formal education represents and reproduces the white supremacy that is inherent to the material taught, the discipline dispensed, and the teaching and administrative faculty hired and fired. The implicit biases of all of us deeply affect students, their chances for success, and their future participation in the discourse of power.

We need to work through the problem of white supremacy in all levels of education and these teach-ins are safe spaces to do that--offering tools to use, knowledge we haven't had, and the opportunity to practice discussion in a skillfully facilitated space.

This series of teach-ins proposes a collaboration among teachers in P-12, higher education and community partners to name, describe, and undo the white supremacy that pervades the organizations in which we work.

A "teach in" is a participatory educational activity to share knowledge and generate energy toward the confrontation of an important political issue. It doesn't limit the time frame or set the syllabus and recognizes a wide variety of types of expertise and sources of knowledge—street knowledge, life knowledge, ancestral knowledge, and book knowledge.

We intend the teach-ins as one contribution to efforts to reimagining and rebuilding our schools and universities as inclusive, equitable, and antiracist sites of educational opportunity.
